RESOLUTION NUMBER 12-1961

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE COMMISSIONERS OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER THE WEST 250 FEET OF PARK STREET, LYING WITHIN THE BOUNDARIES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO REQUEST SUCH SURRENDER OF JURISDICTION ON BEHALF OF THE CITY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS it has been considered and deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, acquire jurisdiction over the west 250 feet of Park Street, lying within the corporate limits of said City as the same is herewith described.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that by virtue of the foregoing and by virtue of the provisions of Section 373.270 Oregon Revised Statutes, that the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, do and it hereby does, request the Commissioners of the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to surrender the jurisdiction over the west 250 feet of Park Street as the same now lies within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be, and he hereby is authorized and directed to request of the County Commissioners of Clackamas County, Oregon, the surrender of jurisdiction over THE WEST 250 FEET OF PARK STREET, a County roadway as hereinabove described, on behalf of the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.
