

RESOLUTION NUMBER 13-1959

WHEREAS, a vacancy has occurred in the office of the City Manager of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, occasioned by the resignation of Earl Burdick as such City Manager, on the 1st day of June, 1959; and

WHEREAS, by reason of such resignation and vacancy it is now necessary that a new City Manager be appointed;

NOW THEREFORE, in compliance with Chapter VI, Section 24(b) of the City Charter, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby declare its intention to appoint a new City Manager after the expiration of at least four (4) weeks from the date of the adoption of this Resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Leonard B. Mullan be, and he hereby is, appointed City Manager pro-tem of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, during the interim period which must expire from the date of the adoption of this Resolution until the City Council shall have appointed a new City Manager in compliance with the provisions of Chapter VI of the City Charter.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the appointment of Leonard B. Mullan is as of the 1st day of June, 1959, and shall continue until a new City Manager shall have been appointed by the City Council, and that he shall receive as compensation for his said services the sum of \$450.00 per month.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 14-1959

WHEREAS, by Resolution of the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, No. 13-1959, duly adopted on the 8th day of June, 1959, the said City Council did declare its intention to appoint a new City Manager to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of former City Manager Earl Burdick; and

WHEREAS, a period of more than four weeks has now elapsed since the date of the adoption of the said Resolution; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has now decided and determined to appoint Leonard B. Mullan as City Manager of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that Leonard B. Mullan be and he hereby is appointed City Manager of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for an indefinite term subject to removal at the pleasure of a majority of the City Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that before entering upon his duties as such City Manager he shall file with the Mayor an official bond in the sum of \$5000.00 for the faithful performance of his duties as such, the premium of said bond to be paid by the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the said Leonard B. Mullan shall receive as compensation for his services as City Manager of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the sum of \$450.00 per month.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 15-1959

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore by Ordinance Number 744 of the said city duly passed and signed by the Mayor on the 22nd day of May, 1959, did initiate proceedings to annex the territory hereinafter described, which is contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 22.120, 22.130, 22.140, 22.150 and 22.170 of Oregon Revised Statutes, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, by Ordinance Number 744 of said city duly passed and signed by the Mayor on the 22nd day of May, 1959, did dispense with submitting the question of such annexation to the registered voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and did fix the date, place and time for a public hearing before it at which the registered voters of the city might appear and be heard upon the question of such annexation at the hour of 8:00 o'clock P.M. on the 15th day of June, 1959, in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, notice of said public hearing was published in the Milwaukie Review, on May 27th, 1959 and on June 4, 1959, and written notice of such hearing was posted in four public places in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for two successive weeks prior to the date of said hearings, and

WHEREAS, on the 15th day of June, 1959, at the hour of 8:00 P.M. in the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, a public hearing was held by the Council of said city at which hearing the registered voters of said city were given an opportunity to appear and be heard on the question of such annexation of territory to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, at such hearing, no registered voter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, appeared and made any objection to such annexation of said territory, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Number 750 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, duly passed by the City Council of said city and signed by the Mayor of said city on the 16th day of June, 1959, the territory hereinafter bounded and described was declared to be annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, upon the condition that the majority of the votes cast by the registered voters residing within the territory be in favor of such annexation, and

WHEREAS, by Ordinance Number 750 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, duly passed by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and duly signed by the Mayor of said city of the 16th day of June, 1959, an annexation election was ordered to be held within such territory on the 20th day of July, 1959, submitting to the registered voters residing
