BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon be and he hereby is authorized and directed to request of the County Court of Clackamas County, Oregon the surrender of jurisdiction over that portion of Jefferson Street, known as County Road Number 208, also known as HARLOW ROAD, as hereinabove described on behalf of the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 16-1956

RESOLUTION REQUIRING THE CITY TREASURER TO FILL AND PERFORM THE DUTIES OF TWO OFFICES, NAMELY, THAT OF TREASURER AND THAT OF RECORDER.

WHEREAS the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, as amended, provides by Section 5 of Chapter II thereof that the City Council may require any officer of the City appointed by the City Manager to fill and perform the duties of two or more offices, and

WHEREAS the City Council now deems it expedient and for the best interests of the City of Milwaukie that the City Treasurer be required to fill and perform the duties of both the City Treasurer and the City Recorder.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, THAT Jean Dillery be and she is hereby required to fill and perform the duties of both the City Treasurer and the City Recorder from and after the 1st day of December 1956.
