

RESOLUTION NUMBER 17-1956

A RESOLUTION RELATING TO STOP SIGNS AT THE INTERSECTION OF OAK AND WASHINGTON STREETS AND AT HARRISON AND 32nd STREETS.

WHEREAS, extreme traffic hazards now exist at the intersection of Oak and Washington Streets and at Harrison and 32nd Streets, in Milwaukie, Oregon, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient to provide that all vehicular traffic be required to stop before entering into and upon Washington Street from Oak Street, excepting that vehicles making a right turn onto Washington Street at the intersection of Oak Street shall be excused from stopping before proceeding on to Washington Street; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient to provide that all vehicular traffic traveling in a westerly direction, in and upon Harrison Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, shall stop at the easterly line of the intersection of 32nd Street and Harrison Street before proceeding in any direction,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON that pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance Number 530 of the said City of Milwaukie, Oregon, all vehicles shall come to a complete stop before entering Washington Street from Oak Street, except those vehicles which turn right into and upon Washington Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON that, pursuant to the provisions of Ordinance Number 530, of the said City, all vehicles traveling in a westerly direction shall come to a complete stop before entering the intersection of 32nd Street at Harrison Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, that the City Manager of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and he is hereby directed to place and erect suitable signs to indicate the stopping requirements and the turning provisions, provided by this Resolution, and to see that the same are properly placed at the indicated intersections.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that this Resolution be and the same is hereby made effective as of the day that such suitable signs are erected at the hereinabove indicated streets.
