RESOLUTION NUMBER 17-1958

A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OFFER OF THE COUNTY COURT OF CLACKAMAS COUNTY, OREGON TO SURRENDER JURISDICTION OVER HARRISON STREET, FROM 42nd STREET TO 44th STREET.

WHEREAS, it has been considered and deemed necessary and expedient and for the best interest of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, acquire and accept jurisdiction over certain portion of a county road lying within and adjacent to the corporate limits of said city, as the same is herewith described, and

WHEREAS, the County Court, pursuant to ORS 373.270 has conducted a public hearing and has deemed it to be expedient and for the best interests of the county to surrender jurisdiction over the County Road or Highway herewith described, and

WHEREAS, the County Court has made an offer to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to surrender jurisdiction over said County Road or portion thereof.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that by virtue of the foregoing and pursuant to the provisions of ORS 373.270 the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, do and hereby does, accept jurisdiction as offered by the County Court of the County of Clackamas, State of Oregon, over the following portion of the County Road as the same now lies within and adjacent to the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, said portion of said County Road being described as follows:

Harrison Street, from 42nd Street to 44th Street, Milwaukie, Oregon




