

RESOLUTION NUMBER 17-1967

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie, by appropriate statutory procedure, has heretofore annexed the following described tracts of real property bounded as follows:

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, and 7, of Jackson Meadow Subdivision, a subdivision of record, Clackamas County, State of Oregon.
(5255, 5242, 5273, 5266, 5288, 5314 and 5326 Jackson Street)


AND, WHEREAS, the above described real properties lie within the boundaries of the WICHITA ZONING DISTRICT, a zoning district in the County of Clackamas, and State of Oregon, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL, OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that it does hereby elect to cause the withdrawal from the said WICHITA ZONING DISTRICT, all that part of said zoning district hereinabove described and heretofore incorporated in and annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that by virtue of the foregoing and by virtue of the provisions of Sections 222.520 and 222.524, Oregon Revised Statutes, the 8th day of May, 1967, is hereby fixed as the date, the hour of 8:00 o'clock p. m., Pacific Daylight Time, is hereby fixed as the time, and the Council Chambers of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby fixed as the place for a public hearing to be held by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to hear objections to the withdrawal of the above described tracts of real properties lying within the above described boundaries from the WICHITA ZONING DISTRICT NO. 9, and to determine whether such withdrawal is for the best interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and he hereby is, ordered and directed to cause a notice of the date, time and place and purpose of said hearing to be published once each week for two successive weeks prior to the date of such hearing, in the MILWAUKIE REVIEW, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and that he further cause notices of the date, time, place and purpose of said hearing to be posted in four public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for a like period of time.
