

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1911

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MAIN STREET
MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the city council of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the city engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an improvement, together with the estimate, of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and,

WHEREAS, such plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the council of said Milwaukie, therefore, the plans, specifications, and estimates are hereby approved, and be it,

RESOLVED, that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its City Council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to wit:

The Street shall be brought to sub-grade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the road bed macadam shall be placed not less than seven inches thick at the curb and not less than nine inches thick at the center of the Street, and when completed the said Street shall be brought to the established grade.

Said street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins and gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of the street, and to provide all proper drainage. Cross walks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications and the whole street shall be completed according to the plans and specifications filed herein and approved by this resolution.

The City Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the City Charter of Milwaukie.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Council of Milwaukie at a special meeting held on the 2nd day of March 1911.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1911

Resolution and notice for the improvement of Washington Street.
Milwaukie, Ore.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the City Council of Milwaukie, Oregon heretofore made, the city engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an improvement according to the petition heretofore filed and for an appropriate improvement together with the estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and

Whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the Council of the said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimations are hereby approved, and be it hereby Resolved that the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its City Council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to wit:

The Street shall be brought to sub-grade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the road bed Macadam shall be 16 feet wide along the center of the Street, 6 inches at the sides, and when completed the said Street shall be brought to the established grade.

Said Street shall properly provided with all drains, catch basins and

gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of Street, and to provide all proper drainage. Cross walks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

The City Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the City Charter of Milwaukie, Ore.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Council of Milwaukie at the 108 meeting held on the 14th day of March 1911.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1911

Resolution and notice for the improvement of Fourth Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, from North side line of Washington Street to the East line of Oak Street.

Whereas pursuant to an order of the city council of Milwaukie, Oregon heretofore made, the city engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an appropriate improvement according to the petition heretofore filed and for an improvement together with an estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the council of said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimates are hereby approved and be it resolved that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its city council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to wit -

The street shall be brought to subgrade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the roadbed macadam shall be 16 feet wide down the center of the street. On the roadbed the macadam shall be not less than 9 inches thick on the center of the street and 7 inches thick on the sides, and when completed the said street shall be brought to the established grade, with branches of the same width at all intersections with other streets, carried out to the side lines of the street under contract.

Said street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins, gutters necessary to preserve the grades imbankments and surface of street, and to provide all proper drainage, crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

The city recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the City Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the council of Milwaukie at the regular meeting held on the 9th day of May 1911.
