

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1914

Whereas, the Viewers duly appointed to make an assessment of the damages sustained, and the benefits accruing to the property owners whose property is effected by the widening of Harrison Street, and to ascertain the names of the respective owners thereof, and make a just and equitable estimate and assessment of the value of the benefits and advantages of the said proposed widening of Harrison Street to the owners of the property effected thereby; and the Viewers having made such assessment of the damages sustained and benefits accruing to said property owners, and having filed their report of the same with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie on the 9th day of December, 1913, and whereas, said report appearing to the Council to be all respects reasonable and just, the council did adopt said report, on the 24th day of February, 1914, by ordinance No. 100 entitled "An ordinance adopting the report of the viewers on the proposed widening of Harrison Street from the northeast corner of the tract of land in the name of the Bonnett Heirs to a point in the west line of the said tract of land 238.6 feet south of the northeast corner thereof, and declaring an emergency"; THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, that the Recorder be and he is hereby instructed and directed to enter in the Docket of City Liens the respective sums of benefits over damages so assessed upon each particular lot or parcel of land, and the name of the owner benefited and assessed, (together with a description of said land) as the same appears in said report adopted by ordinance No. 100.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1914

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF LAUREL AVENUE IN THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the Town Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report, and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Town of Milwaukie plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Laurel Avenue according to the petition heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, And Whereas, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie: THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby adopted and approved, And BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie, by its Council, to make said improvements, being described as follows, to-wit:

That said Street shall be improved by grading the same to the established grade; by constructing concrete sidewalks five (5) feet in width, distance from the property line as required by City Ordinance, curbs to be of cement and parkings on both sides to be eight (8) feet in width; by constructing cross-walks; center of street to be provided with twelve (12) gravel roadway; by providing drainage pipes, inlets, gutters etc., and other incidentals to a proper improvement, as provided by the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie and approved by this resolution.

The Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.
