RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1925

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie that the following entitled proposed amendments to the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of the Town of Milwaukie at a special city election to be held therein on Monday the 18th day of May, 1925, for their adoption or rejection: "A Bill for an Act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, by adding thereto the following sections, which shall be designated and may be cited as the Street Paving Amendment, authorizing and empowering the Town of Milwaukie to pave with hard surface pavement to a width of sixteen (16) feet the following streets in said Town: Washington Street from 27th Street to Elmer Street; Elmer Street from Washington Street to Oak Street; Oak Street from Elmer Street to East Monroe Street; East Monroe Street from Oak Street to 42nd Street; Harrison Street from the end of the present pavement to 42nd Street, and 32nd Street from Harrison Street northerly to the city limits, and for that purpose to issue and dispose of general obligation bonds of the Town of Milwaukie in the amount not exceeding Thirty-five Thousand (\$35,000.00) Dollars, and to levy and collect a special annual tax not exceeding five and one-half ( $5\frac{1}{2}$ ) mills on the dollar on all the taxable property within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, until said bonds are paid; also A Bill for an Act entitled, "A Bill for an Act to amend the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, by adding thereto the following sections, which shall be designated and may be cited as the "Sewer Construction Amendment," to authorize and empower the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, to construct and lay sewers and drains, with all man-holes, lamp-holes, catch basins and branches, and to repair and relay the same and to levy and collect an assessment upon all lots and parcels of land specially benefited by such sewers or drains, to defray the whole or any portion of the cost and expense thereof, and to determine what lands are specially benefited by such sewer or drain, and the amount to which each lot or parcel of land is benefited; to provided the manner of the payment of the assessment levied to pay the cost and expense of said sewer or drain, and authorizing the issuance of improvement bonds, and to repeal all provisions of the Charter and ordinances of the Town of Milwaukie in conflict herewith."

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1925

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF 32ND STREET FROM THE NORTH PROPERTY LINE OF HARRISON STREET NORTHERLY TO THE CITY LIMITS.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Town plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of 32nd Street from the north property line of Harrison Street northerly to the city limits, according to the petition heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas,

said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie:

Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. And be it further resolved that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement, described as follows, to-wit:

(1). That said 32nd Street be improved from the north line of Harrison Street northerly to the city limits by scarifying and surfacing with crushed rock to a proper grade the present roadway to a width of 18 feet, making a suitable foundation for receiving Bitulithic pavement 16 feet in width.

(2). By placing a four inch one-course concrete sidewalk, 4 feet in width along the east side of Blocks 1 and 2 Leo.

(3). By placing a four inch concrete sidewalk four feet in width along the west side of Blocks 1 and 2 Leo First Addition.

(4). By placing a four inch crushed rock screenings sidewalk four feet in width along the west property line of 32nd Street from the north side of Meeks Avenue to the City Limits.

(5). By placing a four inch one-course concrete sidewalk four feet in width along the east side of 32nd Street from the north side of Block 2 Leo First Addition north to city limits. All of said work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of said Town on or before ten days from the 18th day of April, 1925. The Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of Town of Milwaukie.

Therefore Be It Resolved by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. And be it further resolved that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement, described as follows, to-wit:

(1). By grading said street to the established grade and constructing thereon a 16 foot gravel roadway six (6) inches thick. All of said work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie and approved by this resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie on or before ten days from the 16th day of May, 1925. The Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.
