RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1947

A Resolution declaring the intention of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to construct sewers, the termini of which are as hereinafter specified.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to construct such sanitary sewers as will make substantially all of the property within the city limits of the City of Milwaukie available to a sewer;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for the appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of acquiring the necessary rights of way, and the cost of the work to be done;

AND WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans and specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, that the aforesaid plans and specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory and hereby are approved.
