

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1, 1951

WHEREAS a congested parking situation has arisen at the corner of 31st and Harrison Streets in Milwaukie, Oregon.

AND WHEREAS it is to the best interest of the public that a two hour parking limit be imposed in the neighborhood.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED; That a two hour time limit for parking be imposed on the following streets:

1. On both sides of Harrison Street from 31st Street to 32nd Street.
2. On both sides of Railroad Avenue from its intersection with Harrison Street for a distance of 100 feet south of said southerly line of the intersection of Railroad Avenue and Harrison Street.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Street Department be and it hereby is instructed to place in such area the proper street signs to indicate such limited parking.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2, 1951

WHEREAS, the parking situation on the south end of Main Street has become so congested that the same now needs to be regulated,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, that both sides of Main Street from the southerly line of Washington Street to the center line of Blocks 37 and 38, be and the same hereby are restricted to two hour parking; and the street department hereby be and it hereby is instructed to erect the proper signs to indicate the same; and that from and after the erection of said signs the said area shall be included in the two hour parking district.
