

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1953

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has entered into an agreement with the Southern Pacific Company, a Corporation and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie has agreed to exchange with the said Southern Pacific Company, all its right, title and interest in and to the hereinafter described premises, for the one half of the cost of the Oak Street crossing signal,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that the Mayor of the City of Milwaukie be and hereby is authorized to execute a conveyance to the Southern Pacific Company the following described real estate situate in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:

All that portion of the industrial spur that lies west of the Westerly boundary of Century Drive and east of the easterly line of that tract of land conveyed by the City of Milwaukie to International Harvester Company by deed recorded in Book 437, Page 462 of the Deed Records of Clackamas County, Oregon, together with a strip of land 32 feet in width upon which said spur is located.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1953

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT, REPAIR AND RELAY CURB AND SIDEWALK ALONG BOTH SIDES OF 32nd STREET, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARRISON STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH HARVEY STREET.

WHEREAS, The Council of the City of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to construct, repair and relay curb and sidewalk, where none exists and where they do exist but do not conform to city standards as to alignment, grade or quality, along both sides of 32nd Street, between the following termini:-

Beginning at the intersection of 32nd Street with the Northerly line of Harrison Street northerly to the intersection of said 32nd Street with the southerly line of Harvey Street.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for the appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done,

AND WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the City Recorder be and they hereby are determined to be satisfactory and approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Milwaukie does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvement,
