RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1958

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER TRUNK LINE ALONG LAKE ROAD AND A SANITARY SEWER ALONG 37th STREET NORTH OF LAKE ROAD.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to construct a trunk line sewer along Lake Road a distance of 950 feet east of the present terminus of the sewer in Lake Road, and to construct a sanitary sewer along 37th Street from Lake Road Northerly a distance of 600 feet, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for appropriate improvement to accomplish the above and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvements, and the location and kind of improvement being as follows:

By the construction of sanitary sewers, and all things necessary in the construction thereof; all to be done in accordance with plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications hereby are referred to and made a part of this Resolution.

Said Sanitary Sewers to be constructed along the following lines and between the following termini:

From the present easterly termini of the sewer in Lake Road, easterly along Lake Road a distance of 950 feet

From Lake Road northerly along 37th Street a distance of 600 feet

That the Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of such improvement is the sum of \$5,500.00.

That the district liable to be assessed for the aforesaid proposed

improvement is as follows:

Beginning at the southwest corner of Tax Lot 4, in the Joseph Kellogg D.L.C.; thence Northerly along the said Claim line to the southwest corner of Block 99, Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland; thence East along the south line of said Block 99 to the northeast corner of Tax Lot 5, said Kellogg D.L.C.; thence Southerly along the easterly boundary of Tax Lot 5, said Kellogg D.L.C. to its intersection with the north boundary line of Tax Lot 11, extended, said Kellogg D.L.C.; thence East along the north line of said Tax Lot 11 to the northeast corner of said Tax Lot 11; thence Southerly along the easterly boundary line of Tax Lots 11, 9 and 12, said Kellogg D.L.C. to its intersection with the north line of Tax Lot 19, said Kellogg D.L.C.; thence Easterly along the northeasterly boundary of Tax Lots 19 and 38, said Kellogg D.L.C. to the northeast corner of Tax Lot 38, said Kellogg D.L.C.; thence South along the easterly boundary of said Tax Lot 38, to its intersection with the northeast boundary of Lake Road; thence Northwesterly along the northeast boundary of Lake Road to the place of beginning.

That the City Engineer's estimate of the cost per each front foot of said property abutting on Lake Road and on 37th Street is the sum of \$2.15. That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcels of land within such proposed improvement district, in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land will be benefitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that written remonstrances against the said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder on or before the 7th day of March, 1958.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of Milwaukie shall, within ten days from the passage of this Resolution, give notice of the passage of this Resolution, by posting a notice headed with the title "NOTICE OF SEWER CONSTRUCTION WORK" in three conspicuous places along Lake Road and in three conspicuous places along 37th Street; which said notices shall contain a copy of this resolution, and shall specify the time in which remonstrances against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that said improvement be made as soon as possible;

NOW THEREFORE an emergency is declared to exist and this resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
