

RESOLUTION NUMBER 1-1961

WHEREAS, by virtue of Ordinance No. 530 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the City Council is authorized to make changes in parking regulations by resolution to become effective when proper markers and signs have been installed; and

WHEREAS, merchants along Main Street as it extends between its intersections with Scott Street and Adams Street have requested that the parking limit imposed upon all vehicles parked along either side of side sgment of Main Street be increased from one hour to two hours; and

WHEREAS, such increase in the parking limit has been approved and recommended by the Traffic Committee of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED that a parking limit of two hours be imposed upon all vehicles parked on Main Street between its intersections with Scott Street and Adams Street in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Manager of the City of Milwaukie be and he hereby is directed to place proper signs to indicate the new and changed parking limits accomplished by this resolution, and that the provisions of this resolution shall be effective from and after the erection of said signs.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all resolutions and parts of resolutions heretofore in effect that are in conflict with any of the provisions of this resolution be and the same are hereby repealed and annulled.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 2-1961

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, by appropriate statutory procedures, has heretofore annexed the following described tracts of real property, to-wit:

The West $\frac{1}{2}$ of Block 32, Gibson's Subdivision of the Logus Tracts, EXCEPT the southeast 80 feet by 130 feet described as follows: Beginning at the southeast corner of the west $\frac{1}{2}$ of Block 32, Gibson's Subdivision of the Logus Tract; thence Westerly along the south line of the said $\frac{1}{2}$ of Block 32, a distance of 80 feet; thence Northerly parallel with and 80 feet distant from the east line of said west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Block 32, a distance of 130 feet; thence East and parallel with the south line of said west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Block 32, a distance of 80 feet to a point in the east boundary of said west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Block 32; thence Southerly along the east line of said west $\frac{1}{2}$ of said Block 32 a distance of 130 feet to the point of beginning.

Beginning at a point that is south 89° 48' East 171.40 feet from the southwest corner of that certain tract of land described in deed recorded in Book 40, Page 14, Deed Records, described land deeded by Dunbar and others to Silverton and Portland Land, Loan and Investment Co.; thence North 505 feet along the east line of a tract of land owned by Seely Norris Bennett and Anna L. Bennett, his wife, to a point; thence East 86.50 feet to a point; thence South 505 feet to a point in the south line of the Hector Campbell D.L.C.; thence North 89° 48' West 86.505 feet to the place of beginning, all being in the Hector Campbell D.L.C., subject to the rights of the public in the road to the south.

WHEREAS, the above described real property so annexed to the City of Milwaukie, Oregon lie within the boundaries of the MILWAUKIE RURAL FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT, a Rural Fire Protection District in Clackamas County, Oregon, duly organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Oregon,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that it does hereby elect to cause the withdrawal from said Milwaukie Rural Fire Protection District all of the hereinabove described properties, heretofore annexed to and incorporated in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon


BE IT HEREBY-FURTHER RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon that by virtue of the foregoing and by virtue of the provisions of Chapter 401, Oregon Laws, 1957, the 10th day of April, 1961 is hereby fixed as the date, the hour of 8:30 o'clock P.M. is hereby fixed as the time, and the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby fixed as the place, for a public hearing to be held by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to hear objections to the withdrawal of the above described tracts of real property from the said Milwaukie Rural Fire Protection District and to determine whether such withdrawals are for the best interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and he hereby is ordered and directed to cause a notice of the date, time, place, and purpose of said hearing to be published once each week for two successive weeks prior to the date of such hearing in the MILWAUKIE REVIEW, a newspaper of general circulation in said City, and that he further cause notices of the date, time, place and purpose of said hearing to be posted in four public places within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for a like period of time.
