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THAT THE CITY ENGINEER'S ESTIMATED COST OF THE STORM DRAIN AND PAVEMENT IS THE SUM OF \$8.50 PER LINEAL FOOT FRONTAGE.

THAT THE CITY ENGINEER'S ESTIMATED COST OF THE STORM DRAIN AND PAVEMENT TO BE PAID BY THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE IS THE SUM OF \$13,000.00.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a written remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder on or before the 9th day of August, 1965.



RESOLUTION NUMBER 24-1965

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER IN MINTHORN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND, ALONG EDISON STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to construct a sanitary sewer along Edison Street from 35th Street to a point approximately 150 feet easterly of 37th Street, in Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland, AND TO CONSTRUCT BUILDING SEWERS from said sanitary sewer to approximately the property line where such building sewers are required.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications to accomplish the above and an estimate of the cost of the work to be constructed,

AND WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, now on file with the City Recorder are found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvement, and the location and kind of improvement being as follows:

By the construction of sanitary sewers and building sewers, and all things necessary in the construction thereof, all to be constructed in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications hereby are referred to and made a part of this Resolution.

That the district liable to be assessed for the aforesaid improvement is as follows: LOTS 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 29, 30, 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, BLOCK 88, MINTHORN ADDITION.
LOTS 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, BLOCK 89, MINTHORN ADDITION.
LOTS 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, BLOCK 93, MINTHORN ADDITION.
LOTS 15, 16, 17, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, West 15 feet of Lot 24, BLOCK 92, MINTHORN ADDITION.

That the City Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of such improvement is the sum of EIGHT THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED (\$8,500.00) DOLLARS.

That the City Engineer's estimated cost of the sanitary sewers in the street is the sum of \$5.40 per lineal foot of property in the assessment district.

That the City Engineer's estimated cost of the building sewers (from the sewer in the street, approximately to property line) is \$90.00 per service.



BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a written remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder on or before the 9th day of August, 1965.



RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-1965

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR THE CALLING OF A SPECIAL CITY ELECTION IN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ON THE 23RD DAY OF AUGUST, 1965, FOR THE PURPOSE OF SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, THE QUESTION OF AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE CITY COUNCIL OF SAID CITY TO INCLUDE IN THE BUDGET AND LEVY THE SUM OF \$294,102.40 FOR THE FISCAL YEAR 1965-1966 FOR THE GENERAL CITY PURPOSES, WHICH AMOUNT EXCEEDS THE CONSTITUTIONAL SIX PER-CENT LIMITATION ON TAXATION SET FORTH IN SECTION 11 ARTICLE XI OF THE CONSTITUTION OF OREGON, AND WHICH AMOUNT IS IN ADDITION TO ALL OTHER TAXES LEVIED.

WHEREAS, the City Council and the duly constituted Budget Committee of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has determined that it is necessary and advisable that there be included in the budget and levy for the fiscal year 1965-1966 for general City purposes the sum of \$294,102.40 and which amount exceeds the constitutional six per-cent limitation on taxation set forth in Section 11, Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon, and

WHEREAS, before said amount so exceeding said constitutional limitation can be included in the budget and levy, it is necessary to submit the matter to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for the purpose of seeking their authorization and approval; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that there shall be submitted in the manner prescribed in this Resolution to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, at a special election to be held on the 23rd of August, 1965, for their approval or rejection, the following proposition:

"Shall the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, be authorized and directed to include in the budget and levy a tax on all taxable property in the said City in the sum of \$294,102.40 for the fiscal year 1965-1966 for general City purposes which sum exceeds the six per-cent limitation on taxation as set forth in Section 11 of Article XI of the Constitution of Oregon, and which sum shall be in addition to all other taxes levied?"

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the election precincts for said special City Election shall be and constitute all of the territory included within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and that there shall be three polling places for said Special City Election, namely
