



RESOLUTION NUMBER 25-1959

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT SANITARY SEWERS IN THE REPLAT OF COLE ADDITION AND IN WALNUT ADDITION.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon deems it expedient and necessary to construct sanitary sewers along

SHERRETT STREET, from 34th Avenue easterly approximately 200 feet.

33rd AVENUE, from Sherrett Street to Mary Court.

34th AVENUE, from Sherrett Street to Barba Street.

MARY COURT, from 33rd Avenue to its easterly terminus.

KATHRYN COURT, from 34th Avenue to its easterly terminus.

BARBA STREET, from 33rd Avenue easterly approximately 550 feet.

33rd AVENUE, from Roswell Street to its northerly terminus in Walnut Addition.

35th AVENUE, from Roswell Street to its northerly terminus in Walnut Addition.

AND TO CONSTRUCT SEWER SERVICE LINES FROM SAID SANITARY SEWERS TO THE PROPERTY LINES WHERE SUCH SERVICE LINES ARE REQUESTED.

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has requested from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of the work done, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED BY THE Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer, now on file with the City Recorder are found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvement, and the location and kind of improvement being as follows:

BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF SANITARY SEWERS AND ALL THINGS NECESSARY IN THE CONSTRUCTION THEREOF, all to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this Resolution.

Said Sanitary sewers to be constructed along the following lines and between the following termini:-

SHERRETT STREET, from 34th Avenue easterly approximately 200 feet.

33rd AVENUE, from Sherrett Street to Mary Court.

34th AVENUE, from Sherrett Street to Barba Street.

MARY COURT, from 33rd Avenue to its easterly terminus.

KATHRYN COURT, from 34th Avenue to its easterly terminus.

BARBA STREET, from 33rd Avenue easterly approximately 550 feet.

33rd AVENUE, from Roswell Street to its northerly terminus in Walnut Addition.

AND BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF SEWER SERVICE LINES, and all things necessary in the construction thereof, from said sanitary sewers to the property lines, where such service lines have been requested by the property owner, all to be done in accordance with the specifications of the City Engineer.

That the Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of the Sanitary sewer is the sum of \$14,045.40.

That the Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of the service laterals where the same are requested is \$100.00 per each service lateral.

THAT THE DISTRICT LIABLE TO BE ASSESSED FOR THE FOREGOING IMPROVEMENT IS AS FOLLOWS:

All lots or parts of lots, in the Replat of Cole Addition, lying within 100 feet of either side of the streets where such sanitary sewers will be laid, as listed above.

All lots or parts of lots, in the plat of Walnut Addition, lying within 100 feet of either side of the streets where such sanitary sewers will be laid, as listed above.

That the Engineer's estimate of the cost per front foot of said property abutting the aforementioned streets where said Sanitary Sewers will be laid is the sum of \$2.40.

That the Engineer's estimate of cost of Sewer Service Lines where the same are constructed is \$100.00 per each service line.

That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcels of land within such proposed assessment district, in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land will be benefitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a written remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder on or before the 9th day of November 1959.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of Milwaukie, shall, within ten days from the passage of this Resolution, give notice of the passage of this Resolution by posting notices headed with the title "NOTICE OF SEWER CONSTRUCTION WORK" in three conspicuous places along the said above named Streets; which said notice shall contain a copy of this Resolution, and shall specify the time in which a remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that said improvement be made as soon as possible, on account of sewage disposal and drainage conditions in said district; NOW THEREFORE, an emergency is declared to exist and this Resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 26-1959

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND DRIVEWAYS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF 33rd STREET WHERE NONE NOW EXIST, OR WHERE THEY DO EXIST BUT DO NOT CONFORM TO CITY STANDARDS AS TO ALIGNMENT, GRADE OR QUALITY, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH WASHINGTON STREET TO ITS INTERSECTION WITH WISTER STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to construct curbs, sidewalks, and driveways along both sides of 33rd Street, from its intersection with Washington Street, southerly to its intersection with Wister Street where none now exist or where such as do exist do not conform to City standards as to alignment, grade or quality, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for the appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done, and
