

RESOLUTION NUMBER 29-1972

A RESOLUTION SETTING COUNCIL POLICY ON THE REQUIREMENT FOR SIDEWALKS.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that any new streets in the City of Milwaukie with 50 foot right-of-way, or over, will have sidewalks on both sides of the street. Any streets with less than 50 foot right-of-way will have sidewalks on one side of the street, preferably on the opposite side from the power poles.


Where new streets are a continuation of a unique or unusual pattern, and/or where installation of sidewalks would not be compatible with the present design, the above requirements may be waived in lieu of another design which will provide pedestrian walkways in conformity with the pattern of development.

Be it so resolved.
