"NOTICE OF SEWER CONSTRUCTION WORK"

RESOLUTION NUMBER 24 1952

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER ALONG PENZANCE STREET ALONG THE ENTIRE LENGTH

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to construct a sanitary sewer along the entire length of Penzance Street;

AND WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for appropriate improvement to accomplish the above and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done.

AND WHEREAS the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder,

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Milwaukie does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvement, and the location and kind of improvement being as follows:-

By the construction of a sanitary sewer, and all things necessary in the construction thereof; all to be done in accordance with plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications hereby are referred to and made a part of this resolution.

Said sanitary sewer to be constructed along the following lines and between the following termini:-

From a point 100 feet southerly from the south line of Monroe Street to the existing sewer on Washington Street, all along Penzance Street.

That the Engineer's estimate of the probable cost of such improvement is the sum of \$1358.00

That the district liable to be assessed for the aforesaid proposed improvement is as follows:-

Beginning at a point on the northeasterly line of Lot 9 Block B Kerr and Shindler's Addition, where the same is intersected by the northwesterly line of Penzance Street; thence northwesterly along the

northeasterly line of Kerr and Shindler's Addition to a point which is 100 feet distant from the northwesterly line of Penzance Street; thence northeasterly and parallel with northwesterly line of Penzance Street to a point 100 feet distant at right angles from the southerly line of Monroe Street; thence easterly and parallel with the southerly line of Monroe Street to a point which is 100 feet distant at right angles from the southeasterly line of Penzance Street; thence southwesterly and parallel with the southeasterly line of Penzance Street to a point in the southwesterly line of Lot 16, Block 3, Roberts Re Plat of Blocks 2, 3, 6, 7, 10 and 11 J. R. W. Sellwood's Addition; thence northwesterly along the southwesterly line of said Block 3 to the southeasterly line of Penzance Street; thence southwesterly along the extension southwesterly of the southeasterly line of Penzance Street to the northeasterly line of Lot 9, Block B Kerr and Shindler's Addition, the place of beginning.

That the City Engineer's estimated cost per each front foot of said property abutting on Penzance Street is the sum of \$1.59

That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcels of land within such proposed improvement district, in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land will be benefited.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a written remonstrance against the said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder on or before the 28th day of April 1952.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of Milwaukie shall, within ten days from the passing of this resolution, give notice of the passage of this resolution by posting a notice headed with the title "NOTICE OF SEWER CONSTRUCTION WORK", in three conspicuous places along said Penzance Street, which said notice shall contain a copy of this Resolution, and shall specify the time in which the remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the Recorder.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that said improvement be made as soon as possible; NOW THEREFORE an emergency is declared to exist and this resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

NOTICE OF CURB AND SIDEWALK CONSTRUCTION WORK.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3 - 1952

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO CONSTRUCT CURBS AND SIDEWALKS ALONG BOTH SIDES OF PORTIONS OF MONROE STREET AND CAMPBELL STREET.

WHEREAS the Council of the City of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to construct curbs and sidewalks between the following termini, along Monroe Street and Campbell Street,

Beginning at the intersection of Monroe Street with the easterly line of 29th Street; running thence easterly along Monroe Street to its intersection with Campbell Street; thence along Campbell Street southeasterly to its intersection with the northwesterly line of Oak Street.

AND WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for the appropriate improvement to accomplish the above; and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done.
