RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1912

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Milwaukie that a bill entitled as follows: "A Bill for an act to amend the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon, by enacting and providing an amendment to said Charter, providing for and authorizing said Milwaukie to appropriate and condemn property within Milwaukie for the purpose of opening, laying out, establishing, widening, altering or extending streets, alleys, boulevards and lanes, in Milwaukie, and providing for right of way for sewers or drains, or for any such purposes, and authorizing the Council to do any and all things necessary to carry out such purposes," be submitted to a vote of the legal voters of Milwaukie at a special election to be held therein on the 22th day of August, 1912, for their adoption or rejection.
