A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPROVING THE AWARD OF A CONTRACT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF 17TH AVENUE (Hwy 224 AND 9515 SE 17TH AVENUE) WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS PHASE II TO WEITMAN EXCAVATION, INC.

WHEREAS, the existing 12" waterline in 17th Avenue at Highway 224 and 9515 SE 17th Avenue is in conflict with the proposed improvements for the 17th Avenue Multi-Use Path Project; and

WHEREAS, these improvements are contained within the 2015-2020 Capital Improvement Plan for construction in 2017; and

WHEREAS, in an attempt to construct these improvements in advance of the 17th Avenue Multi-Use Path which is planned for construction in 2016; and

WHEREAS, the 2015-2016 biannual budget contains enough funding due to the postponement of the McBrod Avenue System Improvements; and

WHEREAS, Weitman Excavation, Inc. was the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved that the City of Milwaukie authorizes the City Manager to sign a contract for the construction of 17th Avenue Water System Improvements Phase II with Weitman Excavation, Inc. in the amount of \$154,840.
