RESOLUTION NUMBER 31-1964

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, AN ADMENDMENT TO THE CITY CHARTER, AS AMENDED, TO BE KNOWN AS CHAPTER VIII-G, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE EXTENSION, IMPROVEMENT AND AUGMENTATION OF THE EXISTING WATER FACILITIES OF SAID CITY, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE ACQUISITION OF NECESSARY REAL PROPERTY AND EASEMENTS IN REAL PROPERTY IN CONNECTION WITH SAID PURPOSES, WHICH PROVIDES FOR THE PAYMENT THEREOF BY THE ISSUANCE OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS OF SAID CITY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,300,000.00 WHICH SHALL BE PAID BY AN AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE; PROVIDING FOR THE BALLOT TITLE UNDER WHICH SAID AMENDMENT SHALL APPEAR, AND CALLING AND PROVIDING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION AT WHICH SAID CHARTER AMENDMENT IS TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is presently served with an inadequate water supply which creates grave dangers to the City and its inhabitants from the standpoint of health, commercial development, and fire protection, and creates a situation not conducive to the present welfare and future expansion and growth of the City; and

WHEREAS, to avoid said hazards, dangers and situations and to provide the City and its inhabitants with protection therefrom, and to promote the best interest of the said City and its inhabitants it is necessary to extend, improve and augment the existing water facilities of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and to provide additional water storage facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has had a Water System Study for Milwaukie, Oregon, prepared by the engineering firm of Stevens & Thompson, Inc., Consulting Engineers of Portland, Oregon, under a planning loan from the Housing and Finance Agency of the U. S. Government under HHFA Project No. P-ORE-3184; and

WHEREAS, the said extension, improvements and augmentation of the existing water facilities and additional water storage facilities now contemplated will be of benefit to the entire City of Milwaukie and its inhabitants and should be paid for by all the taxpayers residing within said City; and

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie desires to amend its Charter, as amended, in order that the power to acquire additional real property and easements in real property and to extend, improve and augment the existing water facilities and to provide additional water storage facilities, and in order that the power to issue general obligation bonds in payment therefor and the right to levy and collect such ad valorem taxes on all of the taxable property within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for the payment of principal and interest on said bonds may specifically be provided for,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that a special election be and the same is hereby called to be held in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the first day of February, 1965, at which time there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for adoption or rejection, a proposed amendment to the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, as amended, which Charter was adopted on November 7, 1944, which said proposed amendment is to be a new Chapter, designated as Chapter VIII-G, and said amendment to be so submitted shall be as follows:

CHARTER AMENDMENT

PROPOSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF SAID CITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON:

That the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, adopted by the people of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, on the 7th day of November, 1944, as amended, be and the same is hereby further amended by adding thereto the following Chapter:

CHAPTER VIII-G

In addition to the other methods provided by the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, or the General Laws of the State of Oregon, and not in derogation of any such powers, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, when in its discretion it is deemed advisable, may provide by resolution or resolutions for the construction, either by contract method or city construction, or both, of extensions, improvements and augmentations to existing water facilities of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and to provide additional water storage facilities, together with all the appurtenances necessary for the completion and operation of said extensions, improvements and augmentations, and for such purposes may acquire by gift, purchase, grant or condemnation necessary lands and easements therefore within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon; and to pay the cost thereof, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon is hereby authorized to issue \$1,300,000.00 in general obligation bonds of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, which shall be paid by an ad valorem tax on all taxable property within the corporate limits of the said City of Milwaukie.

The City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, each year shall provide in the budget for sufficient funds to pay the principal and interest on said general obligation bonds of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, which taxes shall be in addition to all other taxes permitted by the Charter, as amended, of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the laws of the State of Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that it is not practicable to submit the foregoing measure or charter amendment in the form and by ballot title required by subsection (1) of Section 20 of Article V of Ordinance No. 735 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and that, in order to truly and impartially state the purpose and the effect of the measure or charter amendment in question, it should be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, in the following form and ballot title, to-wit:

PROPOSED AMENDMENT TO THE CITY CHARTER.

Shall the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, as amended, be further amended by adding thereto a Chapter to be known as Chapter VIII-G, authorizing and empowering the City Council to extend, improve and augment the existing water facilities of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and to provide additional water storage facilities; authorizing and empowering the City Council to acquire by gift, purchase, grant or condemnation, the necessary land and easements therefore; authorizing and empowering the City Council to issue general obligation bonds of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon in the amount of \$1,300,000.00 which shall be paid by an annual ad valorem tax on all taxable property within the corporate limits of said City that is in addition to all other taxes permitted by the Charter, as amended, or the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and the laws of the State of Oregon; and authorizing, empowering and directing the City Council to provide each year in the budget of said City for sufficient funds to pay the principal and interest on said general obligation bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the election precincts for said special election shall be and constitute all of the territory within the corporate limits of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and that there be and there are hereby established three (3) polling places for the reception of the ballots to be cast by the legal voters of said City at said special city election. The said polling places so established shall be open from 8:00 o'clock a.m. to 8:00 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that voters registered in regular Milwaukie Voting Precincts numbered 201, 202, 203, 204, 207, 213, 214, 217, 222, 224 and 226 will vote at the CITY HALL BUILDING.

That voters registered in regular Milwaukie Precincts numbered 205, 208, 209, 210, 211, 212, 215, 218, 219 and 223 will vote at the ARDENWALD GRADE SCHOOL BUILDING;

That voters registered in regular Milwaukie Precincts numbered 206, 216, 220, 221 and 225 will vote at the WILBUR ROWE JUNIOR HIGH SCHOOL BUILDING.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the following named persons, all legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, are hereby designated and appointed as chairmen and clerks of election, to act as the election boards at such polling places, and on such date, to-wit:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, be and he hereby is directed to give at least ten (10) days' notice of the special election hereby called by posting notices thereof in not less than three public places within the boundaries of Milwaukie, Oregon, and by publishing said notice once in the official city newspaper, the MILWAUKIE REVIEW. The said notice shall be in the following form:

The polls for the reception of the ballots cast for or against the adoption of said Charter Amendment will, on said day and date at the places aforesaid, be open at the hour of 8:00 o'clock a.m., Pacific Standard Time, and remain open until the hour of 8:00 o'clock p.m., Pacific Standard Time, of the said day, at which hour the same shall be closed.

The original Resolution containing the proposed Charter Amendment in full is on file with the City Recorder at the Recorder's office in the City Hall of Milwaukie, Oregon, and is there available for inspection. Such Resolution is hereby referred to and by reference made a part hereof.
