WHEREAS, the said Pvt. LEWIS DIETZ, was a resident of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and leaves therein survivors, and

WHEREAS, Pvt. LEWIS DIETZ, had a commendable record in the Armed Forces of the United States of America and has given his full measure of devotion to his country,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Milwaukie, in regular session assembled does by this resolution express its deep sorrow for the untimely death of Pvt. LEWIS DIETZ, and its full appreciation of the service that he has rendered to the citizens of the City of Milwaukie and to his country, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that a certified copy of this resolution, properly prepared and signed by the Mayor and the members of this Council, be forwarded to the members of Pvt. LEWIS DIETZ'S family as an expression of regret of the City Council for the untimely death of Pvt. LEWIS DIETZ, and as an expression of the appreciation for services which he has performed for and in behalf of the citizens of Milwaukie and the United States.


