

RESOLUTION NUMBER 31-1965

WHEREAS, by virtue of Ordinance Number 1021 of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, the City Council is authorized to make changes in traffic controls by resolution which shall become effective upon installation of appropriate traffic signs, signals, markings or devices; and

WHEREAS, traffic hazards have developed at the intersection of Milport Road and Main Street in said City; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that all vehicles proceeding in a southerly or northerly direction along Main Street be and they are hereby required to come to a complete stop before entering the intersection of Main Street with Milport Road in the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and that a proper stop sign be posted at an appropriate place to indicate the required stop.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this Resolution shall be and become effective from and after the erection and posting of the said stop signs as hereinabove required.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 33-1965

WHEREAS, the area identified as Kuehn Court and Lake Road is not within the limits of the City of Milwaukie, and is under the jurisdiction of the Planning Commission of the Clackamas County Commission, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to a petition by Paul Hostetler, PZC 104-65, the Clackamas Planning Commission has recommended to the Clackamas County Commission, a zone change from R10 to MRL, and

WHEREAS, this area is in close proximity to the existing line of the City limits of Milwaukie and is expected to become a part of the City by annexation in the foreseeable future, and

WHEREAS, this area is identified as a reasonable extension of an existing primary residential area, and

WHEREAS, it has been understood by the City of Milwaukie that during the period of interim zoning, that this district will be limited in use to single family residences to the exclusion of industrial, commercial and multi-family units, and

WHEREAS, there has been no showing of sufficient changes in the character of the neighborhood to justify change in the zoning ordinance.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the Milwaukie City Council by its action does file its protest to the recommendation of the Clackamas County Planning Commission whereby the area hereinabove described would be changed from R10 to MRL and further files with the Clackamas County Planning Commission its continued protest to any future application for zone changes for such non-conforming use in the same area.
