

RESOLUTION NO. 36-2013

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, APPROVING AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH METRO TO ACCEPT CONSTRUCTION EXCISE TAX GRANT FUNDS FOR THE COMMERCIAL CORE ENHANCEMENT PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT ON BEHALF OF THE MAYOR.

WHEREAS, over the past several years, Council has expressed an interest in addressing long-standing issues in downtown and central Milwaukie; and

WHEREAS, Council directed staff to apply for funding through the Metro Construction Excise Tax (CET) grant program; and

WHEREAS, City staff applied for and received a \$224,000 grant from the Metro Construction Excise Tax (CET) grant program to fund the City's Commercial Core Enhancement Program; and

WHEREAS, Council has identified need for an update to the code and plans in Downtown Milwaukie; and

WHEREAS, Council has identified the need for a land use and transportation plan for Central Milwaukie; and

WHEREAS, Council has identified the need for implementation of the 2012 Neighborhood Main Streets project Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Commercial Core Enhancement Program addresses these needs;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that that the Council authorizes the Mayor to sign an intergovernmental agreement (IGA) with Metro to fund the City's Commercial Core Enhancement Program.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on May 7, 2013.

This resolution is effective on May 8, 2013.


