

RESOLUTION NUMBER 39-1967

A RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR ADOPTION OF THE STATE OF OREGON PUBLIC EMPLOYES RETIREMENT SYSTEM, FOR EMPLOYES OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO BE EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 1968.

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered proposals for retirement of employees of the City of Milwaukie; and


WHEREAS, on the 14th day of June, 1965, a Retirement Study Committee was appointed by the Mayor to review various retirement programs available to the City and make recommendation thereon; and


WHEREAS, the Committee so appointed, has recommended to the City Council that a satisfactory plan for employees would be the State of Oregon Public Employees Retirement System; and,

WHEREAS, due consideration has been given to the recommendation of the Committee appointed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City of Milwaukie adopt for its eligible employees, the State of Oregon Public Employees Retirement System, to be effective January 1, 1968, and that from the date of adoption, unlimited prior service credits be allowed for all employees.
