

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1914

Whereas, pursuant to a petition of the property owners along Laurel Avenue, the Council of the Town of Milwaukie has heretofore started proceedings for the improvement of said Street from Cleveland Avenue to Railroad Avenue, AND whereas the abutting property owners along said street are desirous of making a different and less costly improvement than that called for in said petition, Therefore be it resolved by the Common Council of the Town of Milwaukie, that all of the proceedings heretofore had in regard to the improvement of Laurel Avenue be and the same are hereby in all respects rescinded and held for naught.

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 4-1914

Resolution and notice for the improvement of Laurel Avenue from the west line of Cleveland Avenue to the Easterly line of a street commonly known as Railroad Avenue.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Town, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Laurel Avenue, according to the petition filed with the Recorder of said Town, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas said plans, specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates be and hereby are approved by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, and be it further resolved that is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie to make said improvements, being described as follows, to-wit:

- (1). By grading to the established grade.
- (2). By constructing four foot concrete sidewalks.
- (3). By constructing wooden cross-walks.

The Town Recorder is hereby directed to cause this Resolution and Notice to be posted as required by the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1914

A resolution entitled, "A Resolution providing for and approving the form of Milwaukie Improvement Bonds and the Coupons attached thereto to be issued under and pursuant to the provisions of ordinance No. 116; authorizing, approving and confirming the sale of said bonds and delivery thereof, and declaring an emergency," was read and approved as read.

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1914

A resolution authorizing the Town of Milwaukie to enter into a contract with the City of Portland for supplying the Town of Milwaukie with Bull Run water was read and upon motion duly made and carried, the resolution was adopted as read.
