

RESOLUTION NUMBER 3-1929

Resolution and Notice of the improvement of Jefferson Street, from the east side of 37th Street east to the City Limits.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his Report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, Oregon, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Jefferson Street from the east side of 37th Street east to the City Limits, according to the petition therefor and heretofore, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and WHEREAS, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie, Oregon, by its Council to make said improvement described as follows, to-wit:

1. By grading said Street to the established grade.
2. By constructing a crushed gravel roadway 16 ft. in width and of suitable depth in center of said street.
3. By constructing the necessary catch-basins and drains and cross-walks.

All work to be done in strict accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, on or before ten days from the 10th day of April, 1929.

The Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby directed to cause this Notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4-1929

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF WILLARD STREET FROM THE WEST LINE OF LOT 3, BLOCK 3, YOUNG'S ADDITION TO MILWAUKIE, EAST-ERLY TO THE WEST LINE OF 27TH STREET.

WHEREAS, pursuant to an order of the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Willard Street from the west line of Lot 3, Block 3, Young's Addition to Milwaukie, easterly to the west line of 27th Street, in Milwaukie, Oregon, according to the petition therefor and heretofore filed with the Recorder, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and

WHEREAS, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby adopted and approved, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement described as follows, to-wit:

1. By grading said street the full width to the established grade.
2. By constructing a crushed gravel roadway the full width of said street from the west line of Lot 3, Block 3, Young's Addition to the west line of 25th Street, six inches in depth, and by constructing an eighteen foot crushed gravel roadway six inches in depth in the center of said street from the west line of 25th Street easterly to the west line of 27th Street.
3. By constructing two course concrete sidewalks four feet wide and four inches thick and 16 inch curbs on both sides of said street from the west line of Lot 3, Block 3, Young's Addition to the west line of 25th Street.
4. By providing necessary drainage and constructing the necessary crosswalks.

All work to be done in strict accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, and approved by this resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of Milwaukie, on or before ten days from the 10th day of July, 1929.

The Recorder is hereby directed to cause this Notice and Resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1929

RESOLUTION FOR SEWER WORK.

WHEREAS, heretofore there has been filed with the Council of Milwaukie, Oregon, a certain petition signed by the resident owners of more than one-fourth the area of the real property, in a certain district, as hereinafter described, within Milwaukie, Oregon, praying for the making of certain improvements by the laying of a sewer, and,

WHEREAS, the Council of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to grant said petition and make the improvement hereinafter described in the manner set forth, and has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement and an estimate of the total cost of the work to be done, and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed said plans and specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder, Now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the aforesaid plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory, and are hereby approved, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council does hereby declare its intention of making said improvement, the location and kind of said improvement being as follows:

By the construction of a certain sewer along the lines hereinafter designated, which said sewer shall include all catch basin inlets, and all other things necessary in the construction of said sewer, all to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this Resolution. Said sewer is to be constructed along and in Myrtle Street in Milwaukie, Oregon, from the present manhole at the intersection of Elmer and Myrtle Streets north-easterly to a point five feet northeasterly of the Southwesterly corner of Lot 30, Block 2, Robert's Replat of J. R. W. Sellwood's Addition to Milwaukie.
