

RESOLUTION NUMBER 43-1968

A RESOLUTION SUBMITTING TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, A PROPOSAL PROVIDING FOR A SERIAL LEVY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000., TO BE LEVIED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$ 100,000. PER ANNUM FOR EACH OF FIVE CONSECUTIVE YEARS WHICH SHALL BE PAID FOR BY AN AD VALOREM TAX ON ALL TAXABLE PROPERTY WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, PROVIDING THAT SAID LEVY SHALL BE USED FOR STREET IMPROVEMENTS WITHIN THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE; AND PROVIDING FOR THE BALLOT TITLE UNDER WHICH SAID MEASURE SHALL APPEAR, AND DESIGNATING THE ELECTION AT WHICH SAID PROPOSAL SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

WHEREAS, the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is now served by inadequate streets; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has been made aware the streets within the boundaries of said City require rehabilitation and improvement beyond ordinary maintenance and repair; and

WHEREAS, the rehabilitation, construction and improvement of said streets will constitute a benefit to the entire city of Milwaukie and its inhabitants and should be paid for by all of the taxpayers residing within the said City; and

WHEREAS, the Council desires to refer to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, a levy providing for a serial ad valorem tax and the right to levy and collect such ad valorem tax on all taxable property within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, thereby to establish funds for the rehabilitation, construction and improvement of the streets within the City of Milwaukie.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that there shall be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, for their acceptance or rejection at the next Primary election to be held on the 28th day of May within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, a proposal establishing a street improvement tax to be submitted as follows:

A TAX FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT

PROPOSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON,

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON;

That an ad valorem tax be authorized in the amount of \$ 500,000. to be levied in the amount of \$ 100,000. per annum for each of five consecutive years at a rate of not more than .81 cents per thousand dollars of true cash value on all the taxable property within the City of Milwaukie; said tax to aid in or provide for the rehabilitation, construction and improvement of streets within the City of Milwaukie.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that it is not practicable to submit the foregoing measure in the form and by ballot title required by subsection (1) of Section 20, of Article V of Ordinance No. 735 of the City of Milwaukie, and that to truly and impartially state the purpose and effect of the measure in question, it should be submitted to the legal voters of the City of Milwaukie in the following form and ballot title to-wit:

A MEASURE PROPOSED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND REFERRED TO THE LEGAL VOTERS OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON

A TAX FOR STREET REHABILITATION, CONSTRUCTION AND IMPROVEMENT. Shall an ad valorem tax be authorized in the amount of \$ 500,000. to be levied in the amount of \$ 100,000. per annum for each of five consecutive years at a rate of not more than .81 cents per thousand dollars of true cash value on all the taxable property within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to aid in or provide for rehabilitation, construction and improvement of streets within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon?

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and hereby is, empowered and ordered to make all arrangements necessary and as requested by the Clerk of Clackamas County, and to secure the necessary supplies for said election, and to contract with the Clerk for Clackamas County and to pay for said County services incurred on account of said election a reasonable sum.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the following is the ballot title and form in which the measure will be printed on the official ballot:

A TAX FOR STREET IMPROVEMENT

Shall an ad valorem tax be authorized in the amount of \$500,000. to be levied in the amount of \$100,000. per annum for each of five consecutive years at a rate of not more than .81 cents per thousand dollars of true cash value on all taxable property within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon to aid in or provide for rehabilitation, construction and improvement of streets within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon?


