

RESOLUTION NUMBER 45-1975

A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OREGON CONGRESSIONAL DELEGATION TO PRESS FOR PASSAGE OF AN EXTENSION OF THE REVENUE SHARING ACT.

WHEREAS, revenue sharing appropriations end December 31, 1976, and

WHEREAS, a lack of congressional action has already delayed extension beyond budget deadlines for the 1976-77 fiscal year, and


WHEREAS, revenue sharing funds are used to provide essential City services, including public safety operations and social services for senior citizens and low income individuals, and

WHEREAS, the need to increase property taxes to cover the loss of such funds would result in an increased rate per thousand of approximately \$.50 in 1976-77 and \$1.00 in 1977-78, and


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that Oregon's congressional delegation be urged to press for rapid approval of legislation renewing the revenue sharing program.

Be it so resolved.


Introduced and adopted by the City Council on the 15th day of December, 1975, at a regular meeting of the City Council.
