

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4-1911

Resolution and notice for the improvement of Oak Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, from the north line of Fourth Street to the south line of the Keil and Beckman Co. Road.

Whereas pursuant to an order of the city council of Milwaukie, Ore., heretofore made, the city engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an appropriate improvement according to the petition heretofore filed and for an improvement together with an estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the council of said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimates are hereby approved and be it resolved that it is the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its city council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to wit-

The street shall be brought to subgrade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the roadbed macadam shall be 6 feet wide down the center of the street. On the roadbed the macadam shall be not less than 9 inches thick on the center of the street and 7 inches thick on the sides, and when completed the said street shall be brought to the established grade, with branches of the same width at all intersections with other streets, carried out to the side lines of the street under contract.

Said street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins, gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of the street, and to provide all proper drainage, crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

The City Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the city charter of Milwaukie, Oregon.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Council of Milwaukie at the 110 regular meeting held on the 9th day of May 1911.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1911

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF MILWAUKIE AND SANDY ROAD.
MILWAUKIE, OREGON.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the City Council of Milwaukie, Oregon heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an appropriate improvement according to the petition heretofore filed and for an appropriate improvement together with the estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the Council of the said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimations are hereby approved, and be it Resolved that the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its City Council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to wit:

The street shall be brought to sub grade the full width thereof between the curbs, On the roadbed upland bank gravel shall be not less than 5 inches thick on the center of the street, and when completed the said street shall be brought to the established grade.

Said street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins and gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of streets, and to provide all proper drainage. Crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.

The town Recorder is hereby directed to cause this resolution and notice to be posted as required by the town charter of Milwaukie Oregon.

The foregoing resolution was adopted by the Council of Milwaukie at the regular meeting held on the 8th day of August 1911.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1911

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the City Council of Milwaukie, Oregon heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Milwaukie, plans and specifications, for an improvement of Monroe Street from the West curb line of Front Street to the East line of Main Street according to the petition heretofore filed and for an improvement together with the estimate of the work to be done and the cost thereof, and whereas such plans and specifications and estimations are satisfactory to the Council of the said Milwaukie thereof:

The plans, specifications, and estimations are hereby approved, and be it hereby resolved that the purpose and intention of Milwaukie by its City Council to make the said improvements, being described as follows to-wit:-

The Street shall be brought to sub-grade the full width thereof between the curbs. On the road bed macadam, cobblestone foundation shall be not less than 9 inches thick on the center of the street and 7 inches at side, when completed the said street shall be brought to the established grade.

Said Street shall be properly provided with all drains, catch basins and gutters necessary to preserve the grades, imbankments and surface of street and to provide all proper drainage. Crosswalks shall be made as provided in the plans and specifications herein and approved by this resolution.
