RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1956

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON TO CONSTRUCT A SANITARY SEWER ALONG MAIN STREET A DISTANCE OF 1354 FEET SOUTHERLY FROM THE SEWER PRESENTLY IN THE CENTER LINE OF HARVESTER DRIVE AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH MAIN STREET.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to construct a sanitary sewer along Main Street from the sewer presently in Harvester Drive, southerly a distance of 1354 feet;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for appropriate improvement to accomplish the above, and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done,

AND WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed such plans, specifications and estimates in the office of the City Recorder;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, that the above mentioned plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory and are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of Milwaukie does hereby declare its intention and purpose to make such improvement, and the location and kind of improvement being as follows:

By the construction of a sanitary sewer, and all things necessary in the construction thereof; all to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications hereby are referred to and made a part of this Resolution.

Said Sanitary Sewer to be constructed along the following line and between the following termini: Beginning at Station 351+54 which point is in the intersection of Harvester Drive and Main Street, Milwaukie, thence south to Station 338.00

That the City Engineer's estimate of the cost per each front foot of said property abutting on Main Street is the sum of \$2.65.

That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcels of land within such improvement district, in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land will be benefitted.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police of the City of Milwaukie shall, within ten days from the passage of this Resolution, give notice of the passage of this Resolution by posting a notice headed with the title "NOTICE OF SEWER CONSTRUCTION WORK" in three conspicuous places along said Main Street; which said notice shall contain a copy of this Resolution and shall specify the time in which a remonstrance against said proposed improvement may be filed with the City Recorder.

AND WHEREAS, it is necessary that said improvement be made as soon as possible; NOW THEREFORE an emergency is declared to exist and this resolution shall go into full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1956

WHEREAS, heretofore certain citizens owning land in that territory contiguous to the present boundaries of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, commonly known as portions of Minthorn Addition to the City of Portland, Oregon, portion of Keil Heights, a portion of the Keil Farm and a portion of the Walsh farm, all in Wichita Precinct No. 5, of Clackamas County, and bounded and described as follows:

Beginning at the northeast corner of Block 77, MINTHORN ADDITION TO THE CITY OF PORTLAND, OREGON, a Townplat recorded in Book 3 on Pages 5 to 11 inclusive, RECORD OF TOWNPLATS for Clackamas County, Oregon.

From said beginning point; thence following the easterly extension of the north boundary of Block 77, East to the northeast corner of Block 78, located in the east boundary of the aforesaid plat of MINTHORN ADDITION; thence following the east boundary of said Plat, North to the northwest corner of the John D. Garrett Claim No. 38, T. 1 S., R. 2 E., of the W.M.; thence following the north boundary of said Claim, south 89° 18' East to the most northerly northwest corner of MARTIN HEIGHTS, a Townplat recorded in Book 27 on page 18, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence following the west boundary of said MARTIN HEIGHTS, South 0° 35' 04" West 246.00 feet to an intersection with the easterly extension of the east and west center line of Block 5, KEIL HEIGHTS NO. 2, a Townplat recorded in Book 26 on Page 3, said RECORD OF TOWNPLATS; thence following the easter extension of and the east and west center line of said Block 5, north 89° 18' West to the east boundary of 42nd Street; thence following the east boundary of 42nd Street, South 0° 45' west 265.00 feet to the northwest corner of Lot 1, Block 4, said KEIL HEIGHTS NO. 2; thence south 89° 18' East 507.20 feet to the northeast corner of Lot 8, said Block 4;
