**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON,
ADOPTING ITS COUNCIL GOALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2016.**

WHEREAS, the City Council periodically establishes goals to guide its actions in carrying out the business of the City; and

WHEREAS, the City Council considered and identified its goals at several meetings throughout the winter and spring of 2015; and

WHEREAS, the City Council encouraged and heard public comments and input at its February 7, 2015, Goal Setting Session; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has worked with staff to prioritize and identify six goals to be worked toward during Fiscal Year 2016, which ends on June 30, 2016, and

WHEREAS, the City Council identified five projects to be championed by other groups, agencies, partners, that the City could commit resources to.

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that the following City Council goals are adopted for Fiscal Year 2016:

- Focus community resources on an all-inclusive bike, pedestrian, and street safety program;
- Library expansion;
- Urban renewal strategy for downtown and north industrial area;
- Proactive economic development strategy;
- Kellogg for Coho; and
- Complete neighborhood parks and develop stronger strategy for maintenance of existing parks.

In addition, the City Council has identified these projects to be championed by other groups, agencies, partners, that the City could commit resources to:

- Development of skate parks;
- Document and celebrate City heritage;
- An emergency preparedness program; and
- A City bag ban.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on **May 19, 2015.**
