

RESOLUTION NO. 57-2012

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, ACCEPTING AN INCIDENT RESPONSE TRUCK THROUGH THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SECURITY'S URBAN AREAS SECURITY INITIATIVE (UASI) GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Homeland Security, Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) provided UASI grant funding to the State of Oregon for distribution to the Portland Urban Area; and

WHEREAS, a list of equipment, supplies, professional services, training and exercise events to be grant funded has been developed through the application process and coordination with the State; and

WHEREAS, the City agrees to comply with the terms of the US Department of Homeland Security, UASI Grant CFDA #97.008, Grant No. 10-170 award including obligations regarding reporting, access to records, financial tracking and procurement, and supplanting of funds; and

WHEREAS, the City will benefit from the addition of an Incident Response Truck in providing improved service to the City especially in emergency situations;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City shall execute the Urban Area Security Initiative Local Grant Agreement with Clackamas County to provide for the acquisition of an Incident Response Truck.

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on November 6, 2012.

This resolution is effective on November 6, 2012.




