

RESOLUTION NUMBER 4-1925

A resolution vacating the following Streets and alleys in Young's Addition, Milwaukie, Oregon, to-wit: All of Madison Street lying between the east line of 22nd Street and the west line of 25th Street: All of Madison Street lying between the East line of 25th Street and the east line of said Young's Addition: All of 23rd Street lying between the north line of Madison Street and the north line of said Young's Addition. All of 25th Street lying between the north line of Willard Street and the North line of said Young's Addition, and all that certain alley running east and west through the center of Block 4 in said Young's Addition, was read and adopted as read.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1925

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF EAST MONROE STREET FROM OAK STREET TO 42ND STREET.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Town plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of East Monroe Street from Oak Street to 42nd Street, according to the petition heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie: Therefore be it resolved by the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. And be it further resolved that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement, described as follows, to-wit:

(1). That said East Monroe Street be improved from Oak Street to 42nd Street by widening the present gravel roadway to a width of sixteen and one-half feet by placing the necessary crushed rock to make a base five inches in thickness.

(2). By scarifying and rolling the present gravel roadway to make a uniform surface suitable to receive an asphaltic pavement of 2 inches in thickness. All work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie on or before the 11th day of August, 1925.

The Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1925

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF 28th STREET FROM THE SOUTH PROPERTY LINE OF HARRISON STREET TO THE NORTH PROPERTY LINE OF WASHINGTON STREET.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the Office of the Recorder of said Town plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of 28th Street from the South property line of Harrison Street to the North property line of Washington Street, according to the petition therefor, heretofore

filed with the Recorder of said Town, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas, said plans, specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. And be it further resolved that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, by its Council to make said improvement, described as follows, to-wit:

- (1). That said 28th Street shall be improved from the south property line of Harrison Street to the North property line of Washington Street by grading said street the full width to the established grade.
- (2). By constructing a crushed rock roadway eighteen feet in width and six inches in thickness the full length of said street.
- (3). By constructing one course cement sidewalks four feet in width and four inches in thickness on both sides of said street the full length thereof.
- (4). By constructing all necessary crosswalks, catch-basins and drains. All work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie, and approved by this resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie on or before the 25th day of August, 1925.

The Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this notice and resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 7-1925

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF LAKE ROAD FROM THE EAST LINE OF MAIN STREET SOUTHEASTERLY TO THE CITY LIMITS.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report and filed in the office of the Recorder of said Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of Lake Road from the east line of Main Street southeasterly to the City limits, according to the petition heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas, said plans, specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted. AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement, described as follows, to-wit:

By constructing cement curbs on said street from the east line of Main Street southeasterly to the City Limits. Said cement curbs to be 18 inches in height with an 8 inch base and a 6 inch top. All of said work to be done in strict accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie on or before ten days from the 21st day of September, 1925.

The Recorder of the Town of Milwaukie is hereby directed to cause this Notice and Resolution to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie.
