RESOLUTION NUMBER 5-1926

WHEREAS, the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, is now engaged in the construction of a sewer system serving a part of the area embraced within said town, and the Oregon State Board of Health has requested the said town of Milwaukie, acting through its proper authorities, to express its intention with regard to the present and future dis- position of sewage flowing through the said proposed system and any additions thereto.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that while it is the purpose of the town of Milwaukie for the time being to discharge the sewage from its said system into the Willamette River in an untreated condition, it is likewise the desire and the intention of the Town of Milwaukie to join in any general plan to stop the discharge of untreated sewage into the Willamette River and the Town of Milwaukie will join and cooperate with the Oregon State Board of Health and other municipali- ties in this state in the execution of any practical plan to purify the Willamette River by eliminating the discharge of untreated sewage therein.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1926

Resolution for Sewer Work

WHEREAS, heretofore there has been filed with the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, a certain petition signed by the resident owners of more than one-fourth the area of the real property in a certain district, as hereinafter described, within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, praying for the making of certain improvements by the laying of sewers, and,

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to grant said petition and make the improvement herein- after described in the manner set forth, and has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement, and an estimate of the total cost of the work to be done, and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed said plans and specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder: now, there- fore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the aforesaid plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory, and are hereby approved, and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council does declare its inten- tion of making said improvement, the location and kind of said improve- ment being as follows:

By the construction of certain sewers along the lines hereinafter stated, which said sewers shall include all catch basin inlets, and all other things necessary in the construction of said sewers, all to

be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this resolution.

Said sewers to be constructed along the following lines, and the termini and routes thereof are as follows:

Beginning at the point where the division line of the Lot Whitcomb D. L. C. intersects Lake Road; thence on Lake Road to 28th Street as shown on the Plat of Nettie Olsen's Addition; thence along said 28th Street to its end, with a lateral North on 27th Street to the northwesterly corner of Tract 7 Hennemen's Acres.

The City Engineer's estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement is Four Thousand Four Hundred Sixty-six Dollars (\$4466.00).

The District liable to be assessed for the aforesaid improvement is as follows:

Beginning at the southwesterly corner of Tract 6 Hennemen's Acres; thence southerly along the division line of the Lot Whitcomb D. L. C. to the northerly property line of Lake Road; thence at right angles to said northerly property line, southwesterly 210 feet; thence at right angles southeasterly and parallel to the northerly property line of said Lake Road to a point in the southeasterly side of Block 2 Hoesly's Lakeside Addition; thence northeasterly to the northeasterly corner of said Block 2; thence northeasterly to the southeasterly corner of Nettie Olsen's Addition; thence northerly along the easterly line of said Nettie Olsen's Addition and the northerly projection thereof to a point that is in the easterly projection of the northerly line of Tract 7 Hennemen's Acres; thence westerly along the said projection and the northerly line of Tract 7 to the northwesterly corner thereof; thence westerly to the place of beginning.

That the above described district is the district referred to in paragraph one (1) of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Marshal shall within five (5) days from the date hereof, give notice of the passage of this resolution by posting three (3) notices headed "Notice of Sewer Work" on the streets along the line of the contemplated sewer, which notice shall contain a copy of this resolution and shall set the time within which remonstrance against said improvement may be filed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that objections and remonstrances may be filed with the Recorder against the aforesaid improvement at any time within ten (10) days after the date of posting of said notices by the City Marshal and the same will be heard and considered by the Council at the regular meeting of said Council to be held on the 13th day of July, at 8:00 P. M.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the said improvement be made at as early a date as possible, as said sewer is urgently needed, and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions in the construction thereof: NOW, THEREFORE, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution shall go into force and effect immediately upon its adoption approval.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 7-1926

BE IT RESOLVED, the City of Milwaukie on and after the 1st day of September, 1926, will not furnish or deliver Bull Run water to B. F. Glover, either pursuant to the provisions of the writing entered into on May 6th, 1919 between said Glover as party of the first part and Town of Milwaukie as party of the second part, or any subsequent arrangement or agreement, or at all.
