

## RESOLUTION NUMBER 6-1949

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Council of the City of Milwaukie that it is necessary that a sewage treatment plant be constructed for the treatment of the sewage of the City of Milwaukie:

AND WHEREAS, a site for said sewage treatment plant has been acquired, and

WHEREAS, plans, specifications and estimates for such Sewage Treatment Plant have heretofore been prepared by a Sanitary Engineer selected for that purpose; and which said plans, specifications and estimates were heretofore on the 9th day of May, 1949, filed in the office of the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie having first been approved by the Oregon State Sanitary Authority.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that said plans, specifications, and estimates be and the same hereby are approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that there be submitted to the electors of the City of Milwaukie, for their approval or rejection, at a special election to be held in the City of Milwaukie on the 15th day of November, 1949, the following Charter amendment:

## SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT BONDING ACT

A bill for an act to amend the Charter of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, by adding thereto a section which may be designated "SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT BONDING ACT", and authorizing and empowering the City of Milwaukie to issue and sell general obligation bonds of the City of Milwaukie in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00; which said Bonds and the interest thereon shall be paid by a general tax on all taxable property in the City of Milwaukie; and the proceeds thereof to be expended for the purpose of constructing a plant for the primary treatment of Milwaukie sewage, together with the acquisition of appropriate easements for intercepting and discharging sewers, and together with the appropriate pumping and other facilities for such treatment plant and intercepting sewers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE:

That the City of Milwaukie be and it hereby is authorized to issue and sell General Obligation Bonds in an amount not to exceed \$200,000.00 the proceeds thereof to be expended for the purpose of constructing a plant for the primary treatment of the sewage of the City of Milwaukie on a site now owned by said City; for the purpose of acquiring the necessary easements for an appropriate system of intercepting sewers and discharging sewers, for use in connection with said treatment plant, and for the purpose of acquiring the appropriate pumping and other facilities for the pumping, treatment and disposal of said sewage; and to authorize and empower the said City of Milwaukie to levy and collect a general tax on all taxable property in the City of Milwaukie for the payment of the principal and interest on said bonds as they become due, and the City of Milwaukie is authorized and directed by and through its proper officers to acquire all real and personal property necessary or appropriate for such purposes, and to employ all labor that may be necessary, and to let such contracts as may be necessary to carry into effect the purpose for which said bonds are authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Recorder give notice of said election by posting notice thereof in three public places in each voting precinct as established by the City Council, and by mailing a copy of Voters Pamphlet to each registered voter in the City of Milwaukie, such voters pamphlet to contain the following:

The date on which said election is to be held.

The ballot title, the number and form in which the question will be printed on the official ballot.

The amendment in full.

A description of the voting precincts as established by the

Council for said election and the addresses of the polling places for each voting precinct.

Arguments for and against the proposed Charter Amendment, if such are submitted.
