
WHEREAS, the said Pfc. CURTIS N. EVANS was a resident of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and leaves therein survivors, and


WHEREAS, Pfc. CURTIS N. EVANS had a commendable record in the armed forces of the United States of America and has given his full measure of devotion to his country,




