Resolution No. 60-2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, CERTIFYING THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE IS ELIGIBLE IN THE 2015-2016 BIENNIUM TO RECEIVE STATE SHARED REVENUES (CIGARETTE, LIQUOR, 911, AND HIGHWAY GAS TAXES) AS THE CITY PROVIDES FOUR OR MORE MUNICIPAL SERVICES.

WHEREAS, ORS 221.760 provides as follows:

Section 1. The officer responsible for disbursing funds to cities under ORS 323.455, 366.785 to 366.820 and 471.805 shall, in the case of a city located within a county having more than 100,000 inhabitants according to the most recent federal decennial census, disburse such funds only if the city provides four or more of the following services:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Fire protection
- (3) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (4) Sanitary sewer
- (5) Storm sewers
- (6) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (7) One or more utility services; and


WHEREAS, city officials recognize the desirability of assisting state officers who are responsible for determining the eligibility of cities to receive such funds in accordance with ORS 221.760.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Milwaukie hereby certifies that it provides the following four or more municipal services as enumerated in Section 1, ORS 221.760:

- (1) Police protection
- (2) Street construction, maintenance, and lighting
- (3) Sanitary sewer
- (4) Storm sewers
- (5) Planning, zoning, and subdivision control
- (6) One or more utility services

Introduced and adopted by the City Council on June 17, 2014.

This resolution is effective on June 17, 2014.
