

That an assessment will be levied on all lots and parcel of land within said assessment district in proportion to the amount to which each lot or parcel of land will be benefitted

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That objections and remonstrances may be filed with the Recorder against said proposed improvement at any time within 10 days after the date of the posting of said notices by the Chief of Police, and the same shall be heard and considered by the Council at a regular meeting of said Council to be held on the 10th day of June, 1946 at 7:30 P.M.

AND WHEREAS it is necessary that said improvement be made at as early a date as possible, and said improvement is urgently needed; and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions in the construction thereof; NOW THEREFORE an emergency hereby is declared to exist; and this resolution shall go into effect and force immediately upon its adoption.
