

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Clackamas County, Oregon, that the City of Milwaukie does hereby urgently request the Congress of the United States to act favorably on the Norblad Bill No. H.R.2828, which transfers to the Housing Authority of the County of Clackamas the Kellogg Park War Housing Project No. 35023, consisting of 600 housing units which from the beginning have always been fully occupied and operated without Government subsidy by said Housing Authority of the County of Clackamas, Oregon.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is in the best interests of public health, safety and welfare that said transfer be accomplished at this session of Congress

RESOLUTION NUMBER 8-X-1951

WHEREAS, The City of Milwaukie, by and through its Council has agreed to sell the hereinafter described premises to California Spray-Chemical Corporation, a Delaware Corporation, for the sum of Fifteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED, That the Mayor and City Recorder hereby are authorized and instructed to execute a conveyance to the said California Spray-Chemical Corporation of the following described premises, situate in the County of Clackamas and State of Oregon, to-wit:

A tract of land in the Wm. Meek Donation Land Claim in T. 1 S., R. 1 E. of the Willamette Meridian, Clackamas County, Oregon, described as follows:

Beginning at a concrete monument at the northeast corner of a tract of land conveyed by the City of Milwaukie to International Harvester Company by deed recorded in Book 429 at Page 228, Deed Records, running thence south on the east line of said International Harvester Company tract, 388.0 feet to the most northerly northwest corner of a tract conveyed to Northwest Investment Company, by deed recorded May 24, 1951 in Book 441, Page 631, Deed Records; thence east tracing the northerly line of said Northwest Investment Co. tract through the following courses and distances (beginning on center

of railroad spur) 26.10 feet; thence easterly 400.23 feet on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 458.59 feet and chord bearing North 64 deg. 59' 45" East 387.68 feet; thence North 39 deg. 59' 30" East 120.17 feet; thence northerly 131.20 feet on the arc of a curve to the left having a radius of 458.59 feet and chord bearing North 31 deg. 47' East 130.75 feet to a point in the westerly right of way line of the Southern Pacific Company (Tillamook Branch) said point being the most northerly corner of said Northwest Investment Co. tract; thence northerly 21.18 feet along right of way line on a curve to the left having a radius of 11,409.17 feet and chord bearing North 9 deg. 06' East, to a point in the southerly line of Harvester Avenue; thence west along said southerly line 526.92 feet to a point of beginning. Said tract is subject to easement conveyed by City of Milwaukie to Southern Pacific Company by deed recorded December 29, 1948, in Book 443 Page 471, Deed Records, and right of way for road purposes conveyed by City of Milwaukie to Northwest Investment Company by deed recorded May 24, 1951 in Book 444 at Page 631, Deed Records.

and that they are further authorized and instructed to deliver said conveyance to the said California Spray-Chemical Corporation upon the payment by it to the City of Milwaukie of the sum of Fifteen Thousand and no/100 Dollars.
