

RESOLUTION NUMBER 8-1926

RESOLUTION AND NOTICE OF THE IMPROVEMENT OF JEFFERSON STREET BETWEEN MAIN AND FRONT STREETS.

Whereas, pursuant to an order of the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, heretofore made, the City Engineer has filed his report, and filed in the office of the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement of that portion of Jefferson Street which lies between Main and Front Streets, in the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, according to the petition therefor heretofore filed, together with an estimate of the work to be done and the probable cost thereof, and whereas, said plans and specifications and estimates are satisfactory to the Council of the Town of Milwaukie:

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that said plans, specifications and estimates be and the same are hereby approved and adopted.

AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the purpose and intention of the Town of Milwaukie by its Council to make said improvement, being described as follows, to-wit:

- (1). By the construction of sidewalks not less than four feet in width and consisting of two course concrete.
- (2). By the construction of 18 inch curbs on each curb line of said street, said curbs to be of two course concrete construction.
- (3). By grading said street its full width to the established grade.
- (4). By the Construction of a 6 inch macadam foundation 50 feet in width, and from curb to curb; and the same to be covered its entire width with 2½ inch bitulithic pavement.

All of said work to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore filed with the Recorder of Milwaukie and approved by this Resolution.

Remonstrances against said improvement may be filed in writing with the Recorder of Milwaukie, Oregon, on or before ten days from the 12th day of August, 1926.

The Recorder is hereby directed to cause this Resolution and Notice to be posted as required by the Charter of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 9-1926

WHEREAS, heretofore there has been filed with the Council of the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, a certain petition signed by the resident owners of more than one-fourth the area of the real property in a certain district, as hereinafter described, within the Town of Milwaukie, Oregon, praying for the making of certain improvements by the laying of sewers, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the Town of Milwaukie deems it expedient and necessary to grant said petition and make the improvement hereinafter described in the manner set forth, and has required from the City Engineer plans and specifications for an appropriate improvement, and an estimate of the total cost of the work to be done, and,

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has heretofore filed said plans and specifications and estimates in the office of the Recorder: now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, that the aforesaid plans, specifications and estimates of the City Engineer now on file with the Recorder are found to be satisfactory, and are hereby approved, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council does declare its intention of making said improvement, the location and kind of said improvement being as follows:

By the construction of certain sewers along the lines hereinafter stated, which said sewers shall include all catch basin inlets, and all other things necessary in the construction of said sewers, all to be done in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file with the City Recorder, which said plans and specifications are hereby referred to and made a part of this resolution.

Said sewers are to be constructed along the following lines, and the termini and routes thereof are as follows:

Beginning at the present manhole located in the intersection of 21st, and Madison Streets; thence easterly along Madison Street 150 feet; thence northerly along the southerly portion of Lots 1 to 5 inclusive, Block 2 Duerst's Addition to the southerly side of Block 3 Duerst's Addition.

The City Engineer's estimate of the probable total cost of said improvement is Five Hundred Eighty Dollars (\$580.00).

The District liable to be assessed for the aforesaid improvement is as follows:

Beginning at the southeasterly corner of Block 3 Duerst's Addn. to the Town of Milwaukie: thence southerly along the easterly sides of Blocks 2 and 1 said Duerst's Addn. to the southeasterly corner of Lot 3, Block 1; thence westerly to the southwesterly corner of Lot 4, Block 1 Duerst's Addn.; thence northerly along the westerly sides of Lot 4 Block 1, Lots 1 to 5 inclusive Block 2 Duerst's Addn.; thence northerly to a point in the southerly side of Block 3 Duerst's Addn. that is 105 feet westerly from the southeasterly corner of said Block 3 Duerst's Addn.; thence westerly along said southerly side of Block 3 Duerst's Addn. to the southwesterly corner of Block 3; thence northerly along the westerly side of said Block 3 to the center line of the Southern Pacific Company's right of way; thence northeasterly along the said Southern Pacific Company's right of way center line to a point in the westerly projection of the easterly and westerly center line of said Block 3; thence easterly along the said easterly and westerly center line of Block 3 to the easterly side of Block 3; thence southerly along the easterly side of said Block 3 to the place of beginning.

The above described district is the district referred to in paragraph One (1) of this resolution.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Marshal shall within five (5) days from the date hereof, give notice of the passage of this resolution by posting three (3) notices headed "Notice of Sewer Work" on the streets along the line of the contemplated sewer, which notice shall contain a copy of this resolution and shall set the time within which remonstrance against said improvement may be filed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that objections and remonstrances may be filed with the Recorder against the aforesaid improvement at any time within ten (10) days after the date of posting of said notices by the City Marshal and the same will be heard and considered by the Council at a special meeting of said Council to be held on the 25th day of August, 1926 at 8:00 P. M.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the said improvement be made at as early a date as possible, as said sewer is urgently needed, and it is necessary to take advantage of weather conditions in the construction thereof, Now, Therefore an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this resolution shall go into force and effect immediately upon its adoption approval.

ADOPTED THIS 10TH DAY OF AUGUST, 1926.
