RAILROAD AVENUE (S.S.Fields) from 42nd Street to Linwood Ave.(Loncoy Road)

FREEMAN AVENUE from Lake Road to its southerly terminus.



RESOLUTION NUMBER 9-1963

WHEREAS, it has been known to the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that Bisio Avenue, from its northerly terminus southerly a distance of 350 feet, a public street within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, is neither used nor useful as a public street, and that the City would be benefited by its vacation; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, after due consideration of the interests of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and its inhabitants, and after due consideration of the interests of the adjoining property owners, deems it advisable to initiate proceedings to vacate said public street hereinbefore described pursuant to the provisions of Section 271.130, Oregon Revised Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has ascertained and has determined that the market value of the property abutting upon said public street to be vacated will be increased rather than decreased by reason of said vacation; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, has been advised that all of the owners of property abutting upon said public street to be vacated will consent in writing to such vacation;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, that by virtue of the foregoing and by virtue of the provisions of Section 271.130, Oregon Revised Statutes, that proceedings be and the same hereby are initiated by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to vacate that part of Bisio Avenue, from its northerly terminus southerly a distance of 350 feet, a public street within the City of Milwaukie, Oregon.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the 15th day of April, 1963, is hereby fixed as the time, and the Council Chamber of the City Hall, 926 Main Street, Milwaukie, Oregon, is hereby fixed as the place for a public hearing to be held by the City Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, to hear objections and remonstrances to the vacation of said public street, if any.

BE IT HEREBY FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Recorder of the City of Milwaukie, be and he hereby is directed and ordered to cause notices of these proceedings and the public hearing to be had thereon to be published and posted as required by the provisions of Section 271.130 and 271.110 of the Oregon Revised Statutes.

RESOLUTION NUMBER 11-1963

A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE INTENTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, TO IMPROVE ADAMS STREET IN DUERST'S ADDITION, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH 21st STREET, EAST TO ITS EASTERLY TERMINUS, AND TO IMPROVE 21st STREET, FROM ITS INTERSECTION WITH ADAMS STREET, NORTHERLY A DISTANCE OF APPROXIMATELY FIFTY FEET, BY CURBS, SIDEWALKS AND PAVEMENT.

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, deems it expedient and necessary to improve Adams Street, in Duerst's Addition, and a portion of 21st Street, from its intersection with Adams Street, northerly a distance of approximately 50 feet, by curbs, sidewalks and pavement, and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Milwaukie has required from the City Engineer, plans and specifications for the approximate improvement to be accomplished, and an estimate of the cost of the work to be done, and

WHEREAS, the City Engineer has filed with the Recorder such plans, specifications and estimate of costs
