Resolution No. 91-2016

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MILWAUKIE, OREGON, accepting the recommendation of the Kellogg Good Neighbor Committee to provide up to \$60,000 from the Good Neighbor Fund for the installation of new lights along the path in the Kellogg Treatment Plant open space along the Willamette River and for the repair of the path for the purpose of facilitating use of the area.

WHEREAS, City Council approved an intergovernmental agreement with Clackamas County Service District #1 (CCSD#1) in December 2012 for provision of wastewater treatment services; and

WHEREAS, this agreement with CCSD #1 established a Kellogg Good Neighbor Fund which receives \$1per EDU per month from all City sewer connections; and

WHEREAS, Council appointed the Kellogg Good Neighbor Committee to advise on the use of the Good Neighbor Fund; and

WHEREAS, the Good Neighbor Committee has recommended the use of \$60,000 from the Kellogg Good Neighbor Fund to improve the path through the open space of the Kellogg Treatment Plant by repaving the path and installing lights along the path;

Now, Therefore, be it Resolved that City Council accepts the recommendation of the Kellogg Good Neighbor Committee for the use of up to \$60,000 in funds from the Kellogg Good Neighbor Fund for path lighting and path repair and requesting that the Clackamas County office of Water Environment Services process the funding request.
