WHEREAS, Pfc. Daniel Mambretti lost his life in performance of his duty while serving in the armed forces of the United States of America, and


WHEREAS, the said Pfc. Daniel Mambretti was a resident of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon, and leaves therein survivors, and


