

RESOLUTION NUMBER 9-1972

A RESOLUTION APPLYING FOR ELIGIBILITY FOR FEDERAL FLOOD INSURANCE.

WHEREAS, certain areas of the City of Milwaukie are subject to periodic flooding from the Willamette River, Johnson Creek and Kellogg Creek, causing serious damages to residential properties within these areas; and

WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968 as amended; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of this City Council to comply with land use and management criteria regulations as required in said act; and

WHEREAS, it is also the intent of this City Council to recognize and duly evaluate flood hazards in all official actions relating to land use in the flood plain areas having special flood hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Code Citations of any state enabling legislation and of any resulting city ordinance that authorizes this city to adopt land use and control measures are ORS 227.220 to 227.280 and city ordinance 1183;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Milwaukie, Oregon that this City Council hereby assures the Federal Insurance Administration that it will take legislative action as follows:

1) Submit a copy of the land use and control measures the community has adopted in order to meet the requirements of Paragraph 1910.3 of the National Flood Insurance Regulations.

2) Take such other official action as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the objectives of the program. Such actions will include but not be limited to:

a) Delineating or assisting the Administrator, at his request, in delineating the limits of the areas having special flood hazards on available local maps of sufficient scale to identify the location of building sites.

b) Providing such information as the Administrator may request concerning present uses and occupancy of the flood plain area.

c) Maintaining for public inspection and furnishing upon request, with respect to each area having special flood hazards, information on elevations (in relation to mean sea level) of the lowest floors of all new or substantially improved structures and, where there is a basement, the distance between the first floor and the bottom of the lowest opening where water flowing on the ground will enter; and

d) Providing the name of the individual and the office that will be responsible for furnishing the first floor elevation information.

e) Cooperating with Federal, state and local agencies and private firms which undertake to study, survey, map and identify flood plain areas, and cooperate with neighboring communities with respect to management of adjoining flood plain areas in order to prevent aggravation of existing hazards.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this City Council hereby appoints the City Manager with the responsibility, authority and means to submit on the anniversary date of the community's initial eligibility, an annual report to the Administrator on the progress made during the past year within the community in the development and implementation of flood plain area management measures and to implement all other commitments made herein.


Be it so resolved.
