



User Guide for City of Milwaukie Zoning Layer in Google Earth


- Use the 'Search' box to bring up a property address. The map will automatically zoom to that address.




- Click on a layer or label name to open a pop up window. The pop up window has the name of the zone and a link to the zoning regulation for that zone.





- Click on the link in the pop up window to go to the webpage. The webpage can open directly in Google Earth or can open a new window in a web browser. You can select where the webpage is displayed under Tools -> Options->General tab (see below).



- Click on the + symbol next to the Milwaukie Zoning layer to expand and see the individual sublayers.




- Click the check boxes next to the sublayers to hide or display the layers on the map. Turning other layers off makes it easier to see if an overlay applies to a specific property. It is also easier to open the pop-up window for a zone if overlapping layers are hidden.



Map shows only the Willamette Greenway layer

- The pop up window for the Historic Resource layer tells the historic ranking for the property – significant, contributing, or unranked. These designations correspond to the regulations in Milwaukie Municipal Code Section 19.403.



- Properties outside of the colored base zone area are outside of the City of Milwaukie.
