



# Hector Campbell NDA

## **February 11 2008 Meeting Notes**

Public Safety Building, 7pm

**Presiding: David Aschenbrenner, Chairperson**

### **Introductions and welcome**

Police Officer Ron Glenn, North Clackamas Schools Supt. Ron Naso and City Code Enforcement Officer Tim Salyers attended, plus 12 neighbors.

### **Police and Fire Reports**

There was no representative from the fire department.

Officer Glenn advised Supt Naso about the issue of the school district needing to provide the police department with written authority to act as their agency so as to deal with crime and trespassers on school property. Mr. Naso advised he was unaware of the problem and confirmed he will consult with Officer Glenn, read the form and report back to the association about his decision at the next meeting.

### **Code Enforcement Report**

Mr. Salyers reported on Oregon legislature SB645 which allows cities to enact ordinances requiring stores to retrieve within a brief period of time shopping carts that have been taken from their premises and abandoned elsewhere, subject to fines if they do not comply. An ordinance will be proposed to Milwaukie City Council in March during a public hearing. The ordinance makes removal of a cart from store premises a violation rather than the misdemeanor crime of theft which enables it to be handled by the municipal court and local police that means it is more likely to be enforced rather than dismissed by a busy court system.

### **Grants:**

Current balance of monies available was distributed. (Information filed). A check in the amount of \$500 was provided to Campbell PTA to help support their upcoming carnival.

### **Hector Campbell Carnival**

Jeff Loudon from the HC PTA reported that the March carnival "It's a World O' Wheels" will have rides, booths and cars, trucks and equipment from a variety of representatives. The Neighborhood Association will have a table/booth. A request will be made to the city to close off 37<sup>th</sup> for parking for the event.

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## **Parks Report:**

No work days are currently scheduled, but Jeff Loudon suggested that if the work day could be on a Sunday, mid-morning, after the Carnival, he would be able to provide additional help for it.

## **Public Safety Advisory Committee Report**

Mary Weaver reported that the American Red Cross emergency preparedness kit information will be provided at the booth at the Carnival. Mr. Aschenbrenner stated he and others had concerns over the appropriateness of the fundraising and accounting for any funds raised for the K-9 unit. Further discussion will be made with the Chief and others over this issue.

The Traffic Management plan is still in revision, and the PSAC did not have comments until it is presented in final form.

## **Projects Update**

The replacement of the Railroad Avenue school zone with a flashing light is still being examined. Mr. Aschenbrenner will contact City Engineering about the cost and process for doing this. Campbell PTA was asked to approve backing the light installation.
