NTMPSP Update – Gary said the projects that were suggested have been turned over to the Operations Dept. The speed change suggestion has been sent to ODOT. They will be requesting more funds for next year.

Officer of the Year Dinner – everyone agreed that it was a very nice evening. We will have \$1,640 toward next year's dinner. It was agreed to send a letter of thanks to the American Legion.

Emergency Preparedness Network update – Dave said that Linda is going to suggest that North Clackamas School District put a plan in place. They are not prepared to use the schools for public shelters. She suggested finding other locations in the various NDA's. There will be an article in the Pilot. There was a discussion regarding shelters.

Dolly – Citizen’s Academy will be starting in September – 13 weeks. If you would like an application contact her or Dave Rash. This last academy was the best ever.

Mary – had a male subject come to her door recently asking about a patio cover – he was from Right Turn Construction and had her name.
