The meeting was called to order at 6:20 p.m.

Dave asked if everyone had reviewed the minutes from the last meeting. Ray made a motion to approve the minutes. Joanne seconded the motion. Agreed unanimously.

Chief – there is a group holding a 5K run to benefit the Milwaukie Daze Parade – being held at 8:30 a.m. on May 22nd. Chief and Beth Ragel assisted in planning the route. Bob's Red Mill will be hosting a pancake breakfast afterward.

Chief - On May 8th North Clackamas Park will be hosting a Military Family Support Day – to welcome returning troops and their families. They are expecting 3,000 people. There will be food/drink/music, etc. The P.D. will be there to assist with traffic control.

Chief – talked about a recent pursuit we were involved in and the subsequent car crash. The suspect was involved in the theft/burglary of a vehicle and lumber. Both suspects are now in custody.

Chief – we hired a new Records clerk – she will start work in May. We may have a second position opening this summer. We are down five officers at the moment due to injuries, etc. We just offered a job to Jake Heimbigner – one of our Reserve Officers. We will hire a second officer in January.

Chief – will be re-starting the truancy court in Milwaukie – in partnership with the High School.

Chief – the High School holds an annual event to raise awareness of drunk driving – we will assist in a mock drunk driving/crash/arrest.

The Chief, Captain Rash, and Det. Tony Cereghino participated in the Hector Campbell event – in the dunk tank.

Ray – asked if it was possible to give warnings or citations to vehicles who park on Washington near the high school. They have the areas on either side of the crosswalk where there is supposed to be no parking, but cars are always parked there. Chief will look into that.

Light Rail Update – Ray said the project’s engineering is at 30%. The environmental impact report is finished. The Council voted against putting a signal on JCB/42nd.

Milwaukie Emergency Preparedness Network update – Linda said that starting next month there will be an article in the Pilot regarding this topic each month for the next few months. The schools will not approve using their buildings for shelters. Neither will the Milwaukie Center. She shared a booklet that is used for mapping your neighborhood, gathering information on neighbors, contact information, etc. It also includes a sign that people can put in their window that indicates if they need help or if they are okay. Ray suggested giving these out during National Night Out.

Officer of the Year Dinner – we received the invoice for \$885 for the food from the American Legion...it has been paid. We will start the fundraising for next year in September/October.

2010 K-9 Walk – Susanna volunteered to organize the event. There was a discussion regarding the details. The Chief will help plan the route.

Mary asked about her term expiring and what the process is. The Chief said he would check with the Council.
