The meeting was called to order at 6:15 p.m.

Ray asked if everyone had read the minutes from the previous meeting. Dolly made a motion to accept the minutes. Cheryl seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

Chief – asked if the Officer of the Year dinner could be stalled until 6:30 p.m. so that more officers could make it. It was agreed.

Chief went over the recent case involving the missing teenage girl and the Sex Abuse suspect that was arrested. There has been a lot of media attention. A local family saw the suspect's vehicle and called the police. They had a GPS system in their vehicle and were passing the information along to the Dispatch Center until the vehicle was stopped. The Chief would like to recognize their efforts. Dolly said that in the past citizens have been recognized before the City Council and given a plaque of some sort. Cheryl suggested we mention it on the website also.

Chief said we may partner up with another agency to obtain a license plate reader. He has talked with a vendor. Portland has two of the readers.

Chief - we're under contact to facilitate the photo red light project. They are in the process of doing that. The intersections will be on Highway 224 and on McLoughlin. There is pending legislation regarding how the vendors are paid. There are only nine cities in the state that are allowed to use the system. We can't use it until ODOT gives us permission to use it on their highway(s). It costs approximately \$70,000 per lane, per direction.

Chief shared some samples of promotional products that the committee might be interested in.

Cheryl had questions regarding media coverage. The Chief said that we give them the information and if/how they choose to put it out is their decision. We also use the Code Red system to notify citizens in some cases. Chief said that perhaps we could post information on the City's website. He will look into that. Dave asked about the recent shooting – he had someone tell him that some of the neighbors were evacuated and kept

out of their houses for hours. The Chief said that was not true. He gave some facts about the situation.

On March 4th the Chief is scheduled to attend the open house being held at Rose Villa, hosted by Tri-Met for the light rail system. He will be speaking. Later that evening he will be attending a meeting between the Ardenwald Neighborhood Association and the Balfour house (JCSRTF).

Gary – NTMPSP – they have five projects that they're hoping to complete by this Spring. 35th/Century Park – the cost is going to be more than they estimated because they have to put in an ADA ramp. They probably won't be able to do the signage project in the Island Station neighborhood. They likely won't be able to increase the dollar amount available for projects next year. Dolly suggested that whatever project didn't get done this year should be the top priority the next year. The rest of the group felt that they should prioritize the projects each year.

Ray – By-Laws are scheduled to be presented to the Council next month.

Ray – Officer of the Year Dinner – invitations were sent out. They made an effort to invite more people. All of the NDA Leadership people were invited. We have received several donations already.

Ray – Work Plan needs to be updated – the group would like to look at some other groups' work plans to compare with. Dolly took notes on suggestions and she will send the list out to the rest of the members to make additions/comments.

Cheryl – her daughter has been attending dances put on by BlackboardMusic.com . She would like to promote their organization and other youth activities. She feels they provide a valuable service – safe activities/environment for youth. Ray asked what exactly PSAC could do to help. Dolly suggested that we could put the information/link on our website.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:05 p.m.
